ForestFit is being jointly developed by industry and the NSW Government in partnership with Australian Forest Contractors Association (AFCA).

ForestFit will deliver two major outcomes for the forest industry:

- A nationally recognised and endorsed pilot Training Program for forest contractors
- A pilot Certification for forest contracting businesses to deliver quality services in accordance with industry standards and regulatory requirements.

Setting the standard for forest contracting in Australia

Influence the design of a certification scheme for forest contracting businesses on 04 March 2021.

Certification design

Working closely with an industry reference group and other industry representatives, ForestFit is building upon and expanding existing initiatives to develop and establish a national industry training and certification scheme.

The design and pilot of the ForestFit certification occurs across five stages with deliverables, activities and key consultation outlined for each stage.

As part of stage one this is your opportunity as an industry stakeholder to input into the certification design. Input from stakeholders representing the entire forest supply chain will ensure the ForestFit certification aligns with existing chain of custody and forest management certifications currently in use by forest contracting businesses.

ForestFit fosters continual professional development, increased business competency, operational compliance and risk management and industry sustainability.

Forest contracting businesses

ForestFit is being designed for all types and sizes of forest contracting businesses to assist them in meeting best practice standards across business management, people practices, safety and environment.

Forest managers, growers, owners and regulators

Gain assurance that certified forest contracting businesses understand compliance requirements across land tenures and have systems for managing and conducting operations to a high standard. Enable easier engagement of high-quality contractors who will manage risks better and reduce compliance costs







Designing the standard
